RECIEPE OF THE MONTH

PROFITEROLES

½ c. water, ¼ c. unsalted butter, cut into pieces, pinch of salt, ½ c. all purpose flour, 3 large eggs, 3 T. grated Parmesan and a pinch of freshly ground pepper.

Preheat oven to 350°. Line heavy large baking sheet with silicon pad or parchment paper. Combine water, butter and salt in a saucepan over med. Heat. Bring to a boil, stirring until the butter melts. Add flour and stir over med. heat for 1 minute. Cool for 5 minutes. Crack eggs into a measuring cup. Use a wooden spoon to beat the eggs into the dough, 1 at a time. Stir in the Parmesan and pepper. Pipe or spoon mounds onto the prepared baking sheet, spacing 2 inches apart. Bake until the profiteroles are puffed and golden, about 45 minutes. Allow to cool completely.

Open up the tops and fill with a variety of items: Ice cream and syrup, pudding, little salads, an herb concoction of cream cheese, onions, etc. Whatever you like. Savory or sugary. ENJOY
